1 Chronicles 29:14

“Both riches and honor come from You , and You rule over all, and in Your hand is power and might; and it lies in Your hand to make great and to strengthen everyone.”

1 Samuel 2:7-8

7 “The Lord makes poor and rich; He brings low, He also exults.

8 He raises the poor from the dust; He lifts the needy from the ash heap to make them sit with nobles, and inherit a seat of honor.”

## 1 Corinthians 4:6-7

6 “...so you may learn not to exceed what is written, so that not one of you will become arrogant in behalf of one against another.

7 For who regards you as superior? What do you have that you did not receive? And if you did receive it, why do you boast as if you had not received it?”

# Perspectives on Money

1 Corinthians 3:13-15

13 “Each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it, because it is to be revealed with fire; and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work.

14 If any man's work which he has built upon it remains, he shall receive a reward.

15 If any man's work is burned up, he shall suffer loss; but he himself shall be saved, yet so as through fire.”

# Perspectives on Money

2 Corinthians 10:12-13

12 “For we are not bold to class or compare ourselves with some of those who commend themselves; but when they measure themselves by themselves, and compare themselves with themselves, they are without understanding.

13 But we will not boast beyond our measure, but within the measure of the sphere which God apportioned to us as a measure, to reach even as far as you.”

“Matthew 6:31-33

31 "Do not be anxious then, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'With what shall we clothe ourselves?'

32 "For all these things the Gentiles eagerly seek; for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things.

33 "But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added to you.”

Matthew 6:19-21

19 "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal.

20 "But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in or steal;

21 for where your treasure is, there will your heart be also."

# Perspectives on Money

1 Timothy 6:9-11

9 “But those who want to get rich fall into temptation and a snare and many foolish and harmful desires which plunge men into ruin and destruction.

10 For the love of money is a root of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith, and pierced themselves with many a pang.

11 But flee from these things, you man of God; and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, perseverance and gentleness.”

Mark 4:19

19 “But the worries of the world, and the deceitfulness of riches and the desires for other things enter in and choke the word, and it becomes unfruitful.”

Luke 16:13-15

13 "No servant can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one, and love the other, or else he will hold to one, and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon."

14 Now the Pharisees, who were lovers of money, were listening to all these things, and they were scoffing at Him.

15 And He said to them, "You are those who justify yourselves in the sight of men, but God knows your hearts; for that which is highly esteemed among men is detestable in the sight of God."
